Addendum to ANNEX I

Identification of landslide phenomena and landslides prone areas into the CKNP and in its buffer zone

The surveying campaign starts in Islamabad where the functioning of the GNSS station installed at the Bahria University was verified. The problem was (and still is) the discontinuity of power supply that does not allow the continuous recording of the receiver. The backup system provided is not sufficient to overcome prolonged interruptions. The collaboration of the Server Administrator Mr. Imran Khan and of the student Shakeel Ahmad helped to point out the solution of the problem.
